Instructions Following Root Canal Treatment

1. While you are anaesthetized ('frozen') and may not have feeling in the area, please avoid eating or drinking anything hot as you may not feel the heat and may burn yourself.
2. You may have had a temporary restoration placed in your tooth:
 - a. If root canal therapy has been completed, you must return to your regular dentist to have a permanent restoration placed. A crown may be recommended. Please call your dentist in a few days to make an appointment at a time that is convenient for you and your dentist.
 - b. If root canal therapy has been initiated, you must schedule an additional appointment(s) at our office for completion.
3. You may experience some discomfort on the tooth that has been treated; this may last anywhere between 7 to 10 days. Swelling in the affected area may also occur. These are often normal post-operative events. If you have any concerns please call our office – 416-961-2273
4. Please continue with any medications prescribed, unless otherwise instructed by the doctor.
